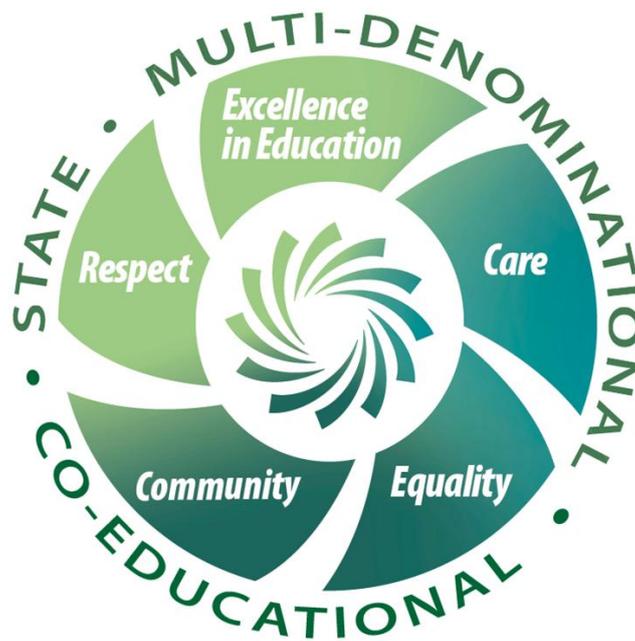

Introduction

The purpose of this updated policy is to comply with DEY Circular 0045/2025, which requires all recognised post-primary schools to implement a policy that restricts the use of, and access to, personal mobile phones for the duration of the school day, including break times and lunchtime.

This policy aims to:

- Improve the learning environment by reducing distraction
- Reduce the risk of cyberbullying and exposure to inappropriate content
- Encourage traditional social interaction
- Support student wellbeing and engagement

Scope of Policy

This policy applies to all students within the school premises, during school hours, and at any school-related activities or events.

General Policy for Students

Mobile Phone & Other Electronic Devices Usage During School Hours

- Mobile phones and other electronic devices must be always turned off.
- The use of mobile phones and other electronic devices are not allowed on school premises.

Emergency Use

- If a student needs to contact a parent/guardian during school hours, they must request permission to use the phone.
- Parents/guardians should contact the school office if they need to reach their child during school hours

Mobile Phones and other electronic devices in Class:

- Mobile phones and other electronic devices may only be used in class with teacher approval for learning activities (e.g., research, educational apps).
- Unauthorized use during class time will result in the phone/device being confiscated.

Consequences for Misuse

- **First Offense:** The phone/device will be confiscated and returned at the end of the school day to the student.
- **Second Offense:** The phone/device will be confiscated, and a parent/guardian will be required to collect the phone from the school office.

- **Third Offense:** The phone/device will be confiscated, and further disciplinary actions may be taken, including detention or suspension, at the discretion of school management. Repeated violations of the mobile phone policy may result in a ban on bringing phones to school.

Use of mobile phones and other electronic devices for Educational Purposes

- In some instances, teachers may allow mobile phones and other electronic devices for specific learning activities (e.g., research, use of educational apps).
- Students must follow the teacher's instructions carefully when mobile phone and other electronic devices use is allowed.
- Phones and other electronic devices must not be used to record, photograph, or video any individuals without permission.

Cyberbullying and Online Behaviour

- Any use of mobile phones or other electronic devices to engage in cyberbullying, harassment, or inappropriate behaviour (e.g., sharing inappropriate content) will be treated as a serious violation of the school's Code of Conduct.
- Such actions may lead to severe disciplinary measures, including suspension or expulsion, depending on the severity of the incident.

Responsibility for Mobile Phones/Devices

- The school does not accept responsibility for lost, stolen, or damaged mobile phones and other electronic devices.
- Students are responsible for the safe keeping of their devices, and the school recommends leaving expensive devices at home.

Parental Cooperation

- We ask that parents and guardians support this policy by encouraging responsible mobile phone and other electronic devices use and ensuring their child understands the rules and consequences.
